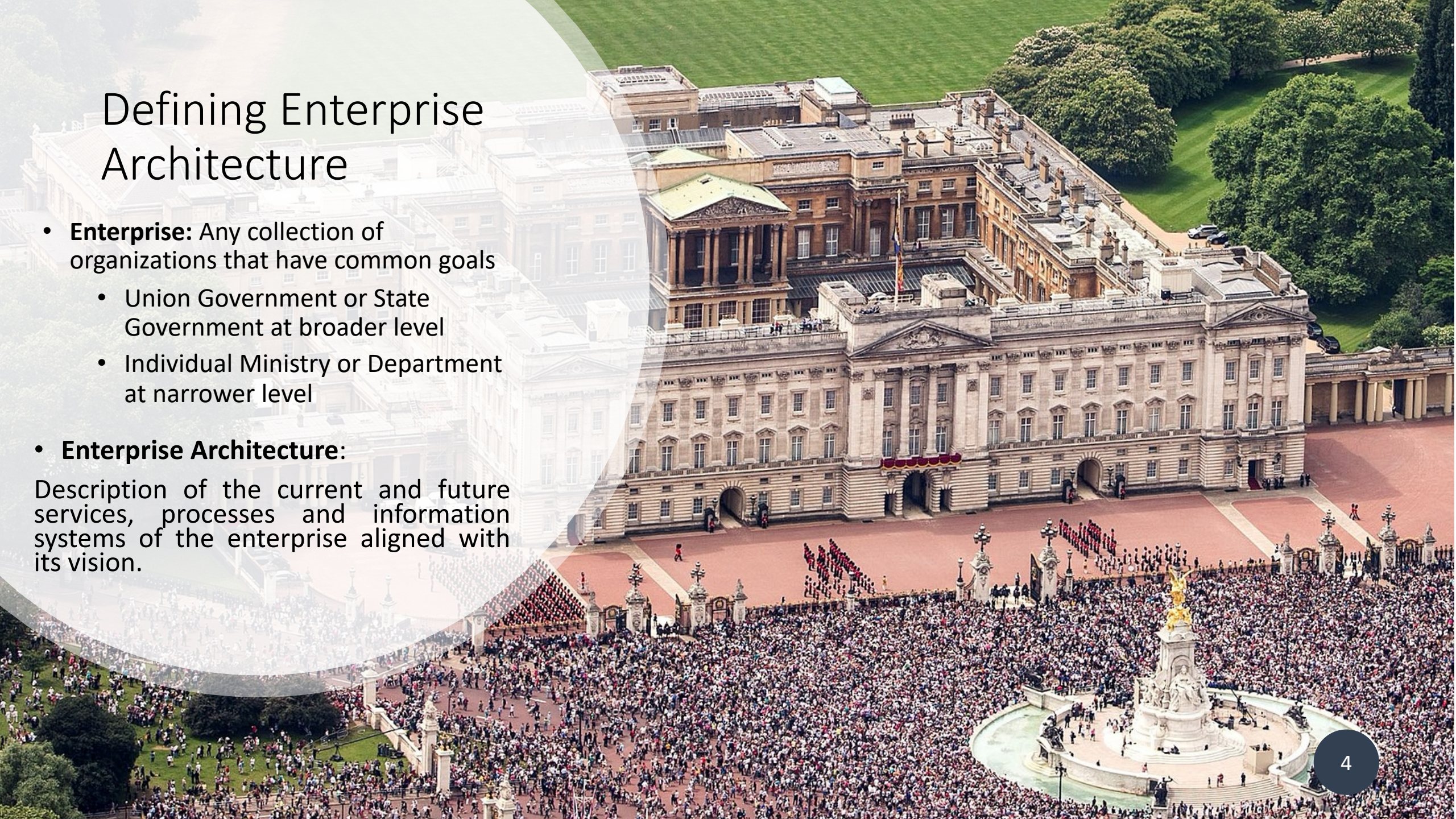


Defining Enterprise Architecture

Defining Enterprise Architecture

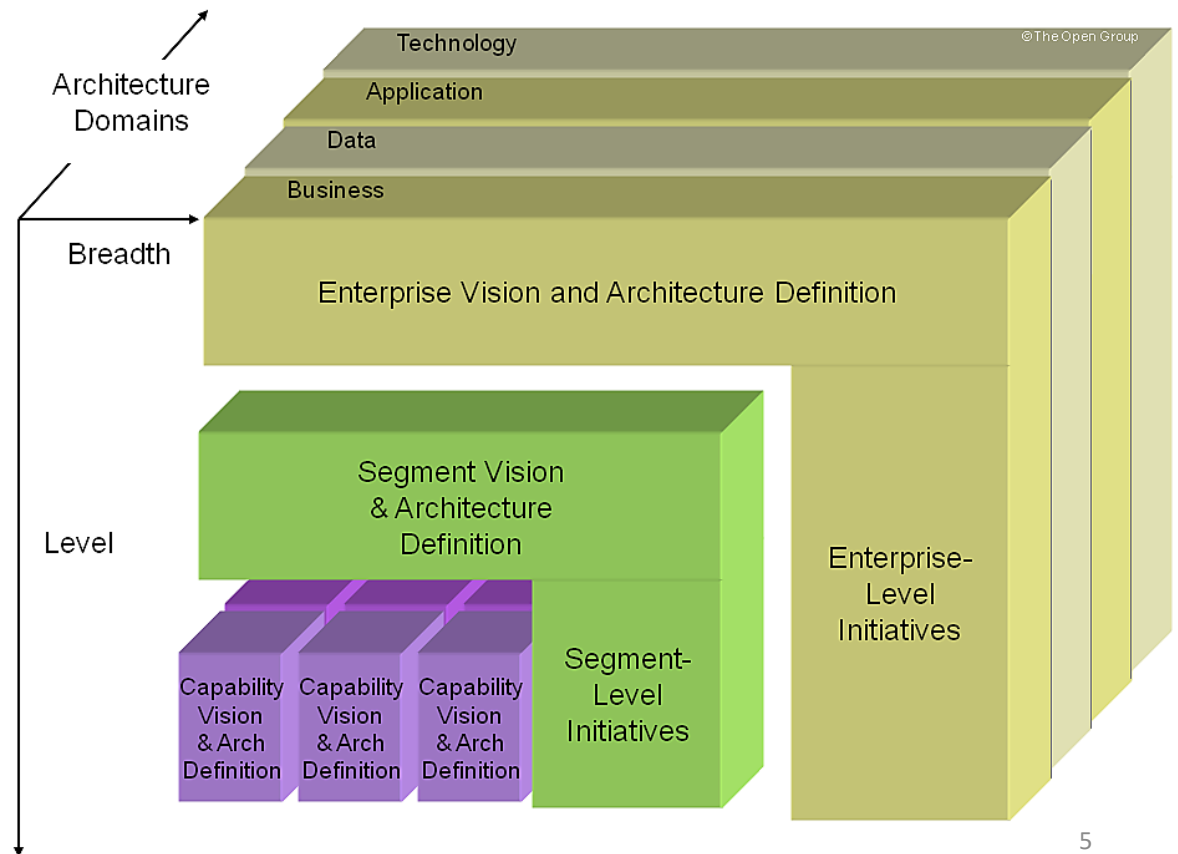
- **Enterprise:** Any collection of organizations that have common goals
 - Union Government or State Government at broader level
 - Individual Ministry or Department at narrower level
- **Enterprise Architecture:**

Description of the current and future services, processes and information systems of the enterprise aligned with its vision.

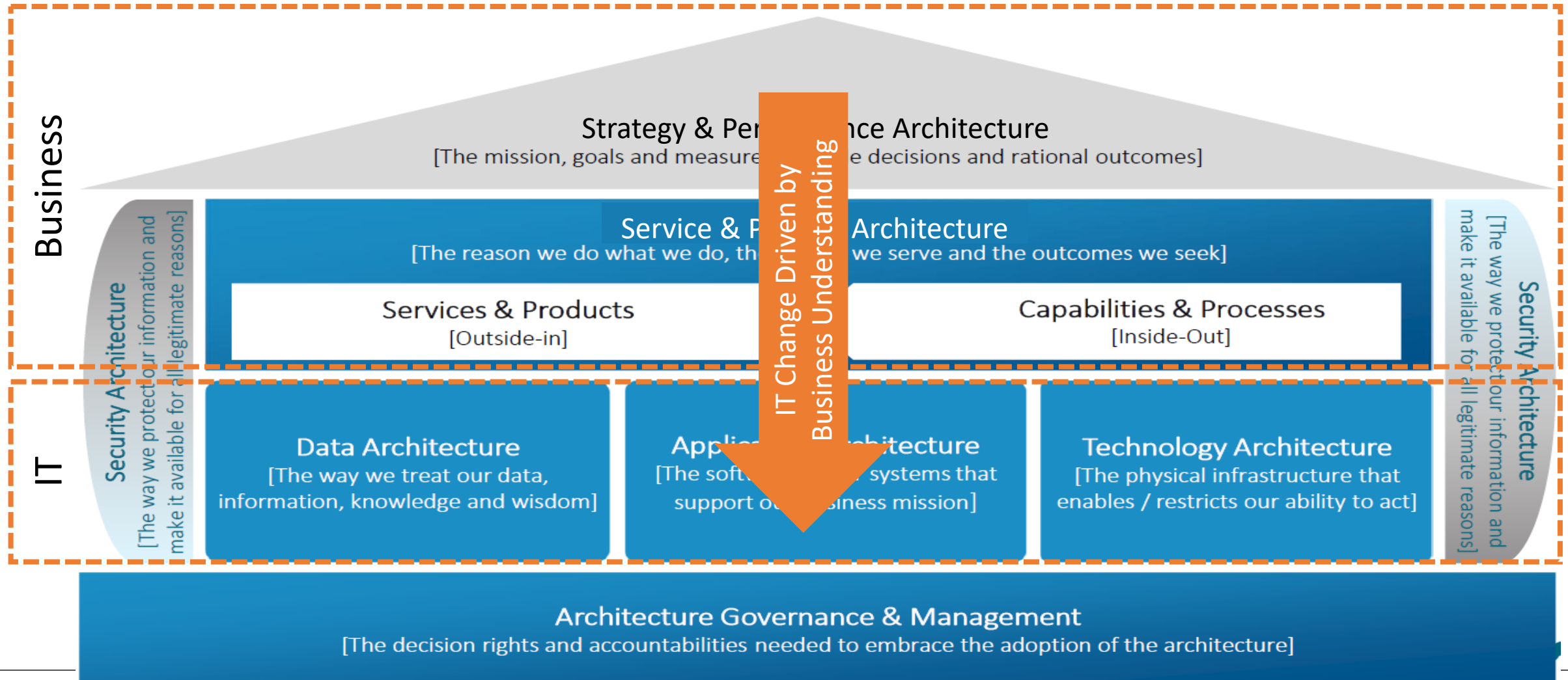


How to define Enterprise Architecture

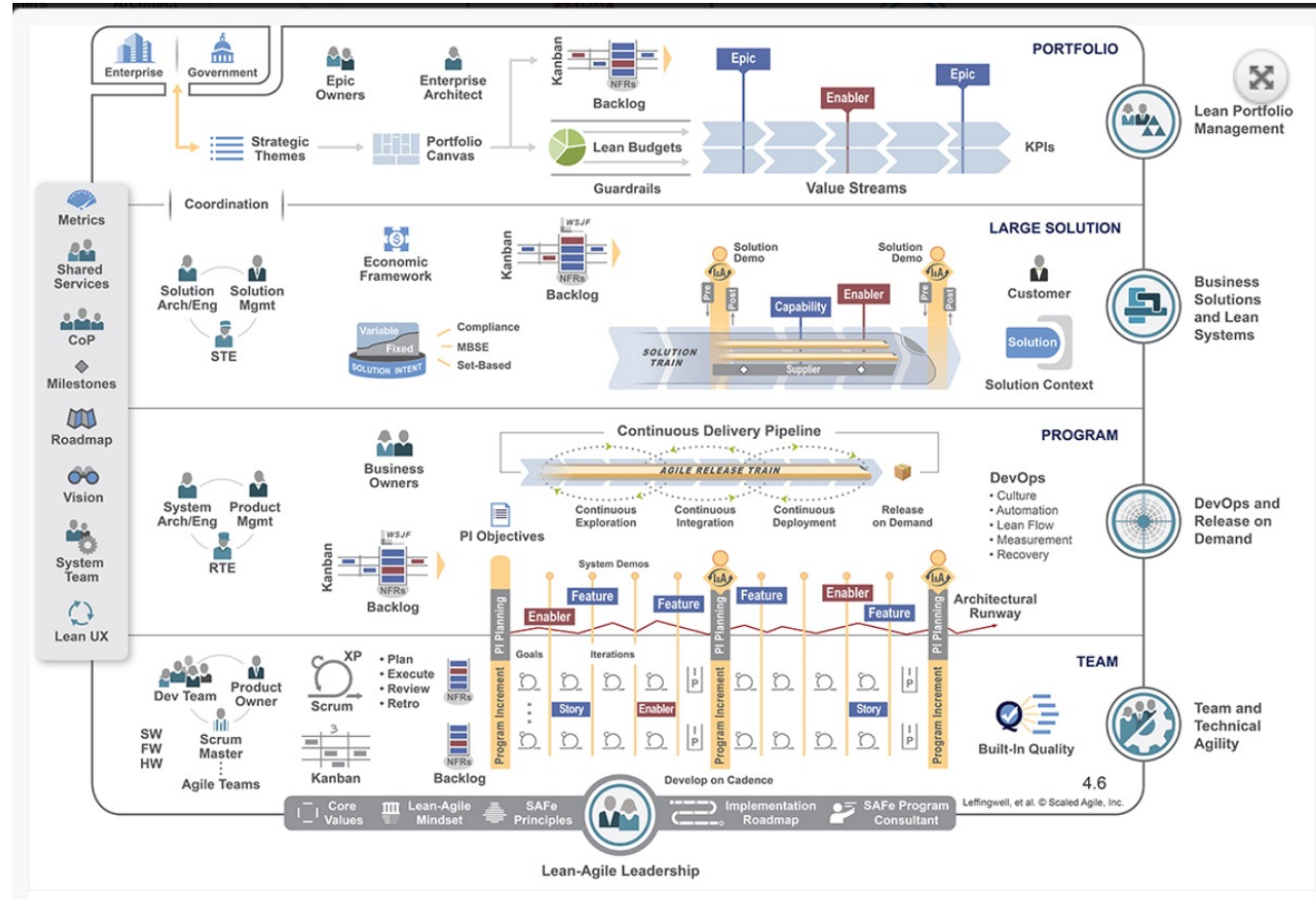
- **Strategic Architectures** show a long-term summary view of the entire enterprise
- **Segment :**
Architectures provide more detailed operating models for areas within an enterprise. (program or portfolio level)
- **Capability**
Architectures show in a more detailed fashion how the enterprise can support a particular (unit of capability).
